It's easy to think we already know the answers based on our experience, therefore we tend to forget what's most important: to ask - AND listen – again and again.













Dalyan in Numbers in 2022






















The Wishlist of our NGOs: **Room** for **Improvement** at Dalyan

With the aim to better understand the needs of our partners, we asked thirteen partner NGOs how we can improve our working relationship with them. We sought their feedback on five core areas of collaboration and had them pick a priority area, which would benefit most from improvement. Though not statistically relevant, the results gave clear signals on how we can improve the way we work at Dalyan and helped us identify potential pain points to look out for.
