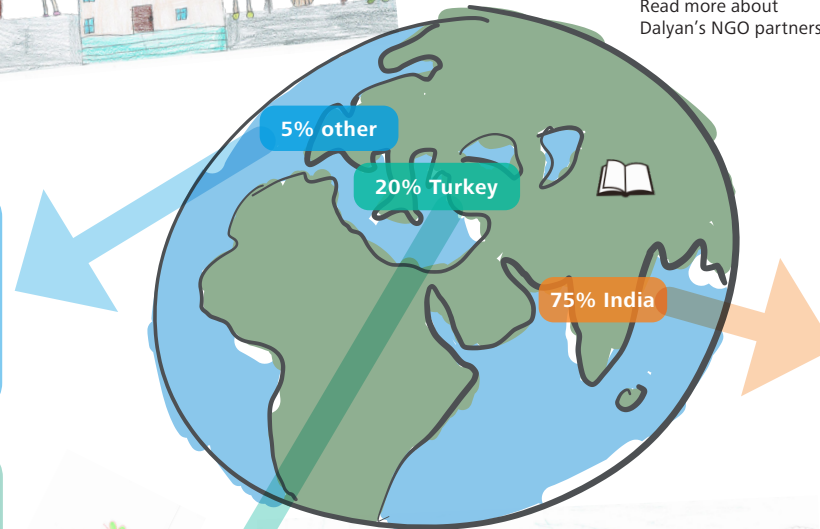

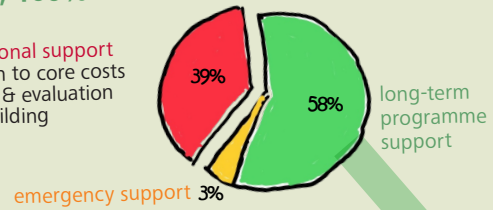

Dalyan in Numbers in 2022

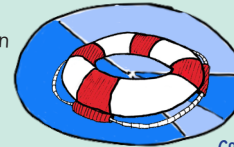
About 40% of our contributions went towards our NGO partners' organisational development in 2022, 100% = 641'000 CHF

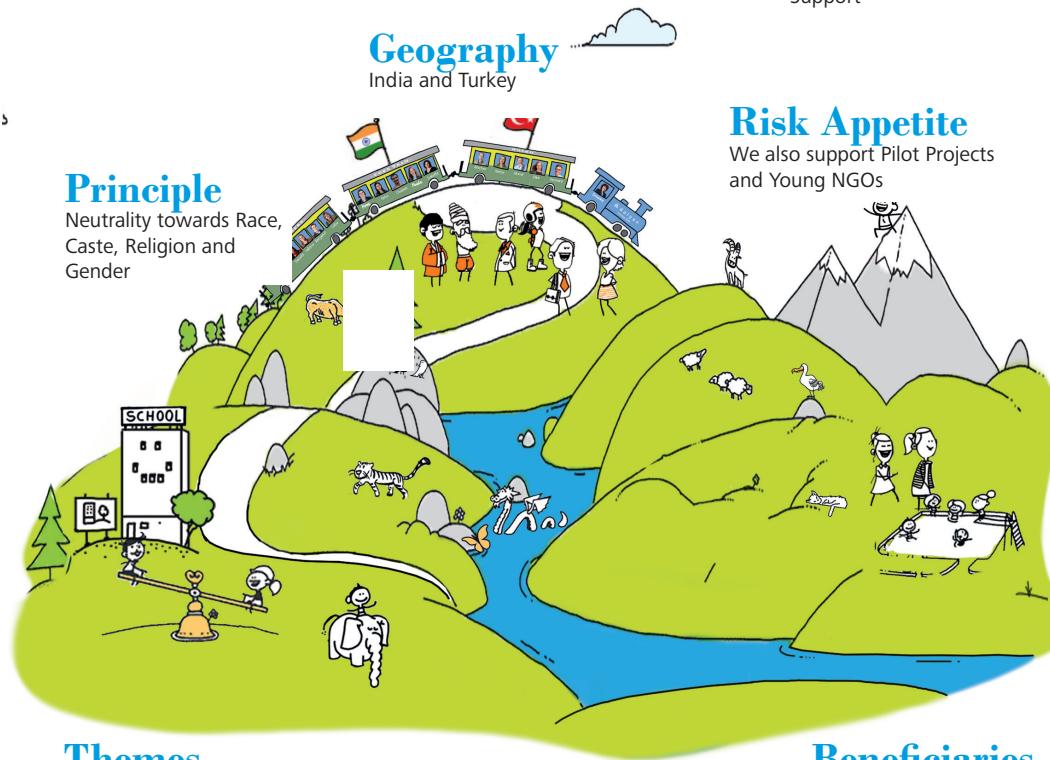
